RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. Riding is a risk sport – **ALL COMPETITORS TAKE PART AT THEIR OWN RISK** and are expected to exercise due care at all times and to obey all notices placed for their control. The Organisers accept no responsibility for any accident, loss, damage, or illness to any competitors, spectators, other persons, animals or property or anything else in conjunction with or arising out of or attributable to the Show. It shall be a condition of entry that each Competitor shall hold the Organisers blameless, and indemnify them against any loss, damage or legal proceedings. All accidents/incidents/falls shall be reported to the secretary (whether or not First Aid attention was required) and assistance must be given in recording the event in the accident/incident book. The Conquest Centre for Disabled Riders has a Health & Safety Policy, which all competitors and spectators should read and comply with. The CCFDR recommend that all competitors should carry personal sports insurance. **SPECTATORS**, whether or not connected with competitors are also required to comply with the above conditions for their own safety.
2. **DRESS – Hard Hats** to comply with the current British Standard with chinstraps fastened and **Suitable Footwear** must be worn at all times when mounted. **Spurs** are **not** permitted in any ridden class. **Showing Canes** must not exceed 30" (unless deemed part of the dress code for the class entered)
3. **IN ALL MATTERS THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.** Any objection must be made in writing to the Secretary's within 30 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a £10 deposit. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
4. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, cancel, change or close classes at their discretion. No refund will be given if classes are missed.
5. Horses must not be galloped outside the rings. Please work-in in the designated area. Anyone riding or handling a horse/pony in a manner that is considered by the Organisers to endanger the safety or well being of any horse, pony, rider, spectator or official will be asked to leave the showground.
6. Any person using physical or verbal abuse against any committee member, judge, steward, official or helper will be asked to leave the showground and banned from entering the show in the future.
7. Any ridden horse is to be at least 4yrs old.
8. **STALLIONS & COLTS** that are 2yrs old and over must be in possession of a current licence (unless otherwise governed by their individual society). Children must have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year to compete in a Ridden Class on a stallion. and their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year to compete in an In-Hand Class with a colt or stallion.
9. All ages to be taken as on the day of the show unless otherwise stated.
10. All dogs must be kept on leads and under control.
11. Qualifiers for **SOUTH WEST PONY ASSOCIATION CHAMPIONSHIPS:** Recipients of cards must comply with the general rules of SWPA and rules for Championship section. All ridden equines must be 4 yrs & over. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday before 1st January in the current year.

- Class 1 Youngstock** - Open
Yearlings, Two & Three Year Olds. Class may be split if sufficient entries.
- Class 2 Mountain & Moorland Part Bred * (F)**
All Part Breds must be registered with the appropriate society and shown in accordance with the rules of that society.
- Class 3 Coloured Horse or Pony * (D)**
To include Piebald, Skewbald, Spotted, Appaloosa, Palomino & Dun.
- Class 4 Open Horse* (B or E)**
Exceeding 148cms
- Class 5 Open Pony* (G or H)**
Not exceeding 148cms
- Class 6 Cob In-Hand***
Any age. Traditional - Unplaited and True to Type. **(C(a))**
Show Cob - Lightweight or Heavyweight. **(C)**
- Class 7 Young Handler *(P)**
Handlers to have achieved their 4th birthday before 1st January in the current year but not their 17th birthday . Class may be split if sufficient entries. No colts or stallions. It is recommended that hard hats to the current safety standard are worn for this class.

To qualify for the Championships:

1. Enter one of the qualifying classes
2. Be one of the two highest placed exhibits not already qualified within the first four and receive a qualification card signed in the ring.
3. Complete the entry form on the qualification card.
4. Return the card to together with any registration fees due within 14 days of this show.

Please note: Registration fee for 2012 is £25 to include all members of the family and equines owned by the family.

- Class 8 Best Turned Out** - Open
- Class 9 Best Rider**– Open
- Class 10 Lead Rein Pony** - not to exceed 122cm***#(K(a),(b) or (c))**
Riders 8 yrs and Under. Rosettes to all entries
- Class 11 Beginners Pony**
May be led or accompanied by a walker. To be judged on suitability of the pony for a novice rider. Help and advice will be available from the judge.
- Class 12 Mountain and Moorland *(M1)**
To be registered with the appropriate society and shown in accordance with the rules of that society. May be split small/large if sufficient entries.
- Class 13 Cob Ridden***
Traditional - Unplaited and True to Type. **(C2)**
Show Cob - Lightweight or Heavyweight, rider to have attained their 15th birthday if wanting to qualify for SWPA **(C1)**
- Class 14 Riding Horse (B1) or Pony (G1 or H1) ***
- Class 15 X Race Horse *# (X1)**
Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Four years old and over, registered with Weatherby's . The equine **MUST** have raced either on the flat, over jumps or point-to-point and must entered in registered name. To be judged on suitability compete in all disciplines.
- Class 16 Family Horse & Pony**
- Class 17 Veteran Horse or Pony *# (v or v1)**
Horses/Ponies 15 years and over
