Show Jumping Rules

1. Shows to be run in accordance with BRC rules unless stated otherwise on the event schedule.
2. Correctly fastened hard hats must be worn by ALL riders, when mounted, on the showground. HATS MUST MEET CURRENT BRC SAFETY STANDARDS AND BE APPROPRIATELY TAGGED FOR BRC/P.C QUALIFIER CLASSES. HATS MUST BE PRESENTED FOR TAGGING / INSPECTION AT TIME OF DECLARATION ON DAY OF COMPETITION.
3. Competitors will be eliminated for excessive use of the whip, spurs, abusive language or for abuse to horse or pony.
4. The Judge's decision is final and the organiser has the right to (a) Refuse any entry with or without reason (b) Eliminate any competitor not adhering to the rules (c) Alter the advertised times.
5. Objections must be made in writing following appropriate BRC/P.C procedure.
6. The organisers will not be held responsible for any accident, loss, theft or damage howsoever caused to any person or their property or their animals on the showground. It shall be considered a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising from such accidents.
7. No horse or pony may compete under the age of 4 years.
8. Horses/Ponies may only walk between rings.
9. **NO dogs** allowed on site during events.
10. Please take your litter home with you and pick up hay/droppings from around your trailer/lorry .
11. The Organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
12. **ARENA RULES**
 - Pass Left to left
 - NO Lunging
 - Practise fence to be jumped with red flag on right
 - Practice fence height not to exceed that of current class
 - NO Jewellery except wrist watch/wedding ring
 - Only person competing in class may ride horse/pony in warm-up arena
